Middle School Art Supplies

Due to CDC guidelines, students will not be able to share or use community tools. To help make sure we can follow these guidelines each student will need to purchase the following:

1. Sketchbook (at least 50 pages of 50 lbs. or more weight paper)
2. A pencil for drawing
3. 2 Sharpies
4. At least a 12 pack of colored pencils (you may buy packs of more colors if you so choose)
5. At least a 12 pack of colored markers (you may buy packs of more colors if you so choose)
6. A pair of scissors
7. A watercolor set
8. A 6 pack of assorted paint brushes (at least 3 different sizes and shapes in the pack)

You should be able to purchase all these items for under \$20. Do as cheap as possible. Here are the best options:

1. Sax Sulphite Spiral Binding Artists Sketch Diary, 50 lbs., 8-1/2 x 11 Inches, 50 Sheets, White (as low as \$3.07)



2. Pencils-(as low as \$1.88)



3. 2 Sharpies (as low as \$1.88)



4. 12 Pack of colored pencils (as low as \$1.92)



5. 12 Pack of colored markers (as low as \$3.61) pack of Sharpie markers recommended (\$6.97)



6. A pair of Scissors (as low as \$1.34)



7. Watercolor set (as low as \$2.80)



8. A pack of assorted brushes at least 3 different sizes and shapes of bristles (as low as \$2.97)



You do not have to purchase the exact items I have recommended, but they should be equivalent or better in quality and quantity. For example, the Sharpie markers are much better than the Crayola markers, but it is your choice of which to get.

If you have any issues in getting these supplies, please come and speak with me privately or email me and we will arrange a method for you to get them.

Each student having these personal supplies, will ensure that in the event we have to remote learning, that they will have the necessary items to complete art assignments remotely.

I will supply students with all other materials in a safe individual manner to help ensure all students have what they need while being safe and healthy.
