Dear Friends,

The purpose of this communication is to clarify details related to the dress code and the use of mobile devices. We have these rules to help create a uniform experience, to minimize distractions, and to help insure a better learning environment.

Below is clarification related to the Auburn Campus dress code. If an item is not mentioned in the code, it is not allowed.

Shoes

Appropriate footwear must be worn. All sandals must have a back strap that is in use. Close-toed dress shoes are preferred.

Bottoms (uniform pants, shorts, or skirts)

Solid tan/khaki, black, white, or grey only are permitted.

Tops

Solid white, black, or grey polos are permitted. Black and grey polos MUST have the school logo. White polos can either have the school logo or be solid white without the school logo.

A uniform polo must be worn at all times.

Solid black or grey sweatshirts may be worn and with or without the St. Dom's logo or logos of schools we partner with.

Sweaters

Solid black, grey, or white sweaters with or without the St. Dom's logo are permitted. Sweaters with patterns are NOT permitted. A uniform polo MUST be worn underneath all sweaters.

Hats

Hats of any kind CANNOT be worn in the building.

Mobile Device Policy

Phones and other portable hand-held devices can be used before 8:15 am, at lunch, and after dismissal.

These devices CANNOT be used in the hallways during transition time during the school day. During these times, the phones need to be off and put in the student's backpack. They may not be visible.

A teacher may allow use of these devices for academic reasons.

If a student uses his or her device at time that is not in compliance with this policy, a faculty or staff member may confiscate the device. The student can pick up the device from the principal at the end of the day and will receive a reminder about the use of the policy. There will be a consequence for repeated violations of the policy, including the requirement for a parent signature to retrieve the device.
